



GUIDELINES FOR HEART OF SERVANT AWARD

Each year the board and trustees of the First Friday Club of Cleveland will select an individual, a group of individuals, or an organization to receive the Heart of the Servant award. This award is presented as part of the annual Bishop's Luncheon.

The purpose of the Heart of the Servant award is to recognize a specific effort or cumulative efforts over the years to broaden, enhance, educate, and connect the Catholic community of Greater Cleveland.

The following guidelines should be used in selecting the awardee:

Impact

Consider the impact the individual has made on the community, including the number of people they have helped, the length of time they have been involved, and the depth of their impact.

Character

Look for individuals who embody the values of the Catholic community, such as compassion, generosity, and selflessness.

Commitment

Consider the level of commitment the individual has shown to the community, including their dedication to service and their willingness to go above and beyond what is expected.

Leadership

Look for individuals who have demonstrated strong leadership skills, and who have been able to inspire others to join in their efforts.

Innovation

Consider the individual's ability to think creatively and come up with new ideas for building up the community and giving back.

Other Considerations

- Strive to recognize somewhat evenly the following three areas: clergy, religious, and laity.
- Strike a balance between prominence of individual and dedication to the local Catholic community and the First Friday Club of Cleveland.
